## SPORT FISHING IN THE TIDAL POTOMAC RIVER LEGAL SIZES, LIMITS AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS

A Sport Fishing License Is Required \* Possession of Fillets Is Prohibited \* Any Fish Caught with Hook and Line May Not Be Sold or Offered for Sale (except by commercial license) • Any Fish Whose Size Is Prohibited, Season Is Closed, or Is in Excess of the Possession Limit Must Be Immediately Released to the Waters Where Found No High-Grading Allowed — It Is Unlawful to Return Fish to the Water After It Is Placed into a Cooler or Storage

All sizes are total length (TL) and all restrictions are subject to change.

### Striped Bass (Rockfish)

Non-Offset (Inline) Circle Hooks are required to be used when fishing for striped bass using cut or whole natural bait. Targeting is defined as "to catch or attempt to catch."

Catch and Release

January 1 through May 15

No harvest permitted of any size

Bait Restrictions:

No live eel. No more than 2 hooks or set of hooks per rod or line.

Summer/Fall Season

Season Open: Season Closed: May 16-July 6 and Aug. 21 - Dec. 31

Minimum Size Limit:

July 7 through Aug. 20 (No Direct Targeting) Minimum 19.0" and Maximum 24.0"

Possession Limit:

1 per person/day

Bait Restrictions:

No more than 2 hooks or set of hooks per rod or line.
